

CYBERSAFETY FOR PARENTS

BULLYING AND CYBER BULLYING VICTIMS ARE 2 TO 9 TIMES MORE LIKELY TO CONSIDER SUICIDE.

NEARLY HALF OF TEENS REPORT ONLINE BULLYING, ONLY 1 IN 10 KIDS WILL REPORT, 70% OF STUDENTS REPORT SEEING CYBERBULLYING ONLINE.

TALK ABOUT BULLYING AND RESPECTFUL BEHAVIOR. LET THEM KNOW YOU ARE A SAFE PERSON TO TALK TO.

SHARING STORIES IS A GREAT WAY FOR THEM TO UNDERSTAND THE PERSONAL IMPACT OF BULLYING. AND ALSO BE HELD RESPONSIBLE IF THEY ARE THE SOURCE OF THE BULLYING

INAPPROPRIATE CONTENT CAN BE DRUGS AND ALCOHOL, FIREARMS, SEXTS, AND MORE. STUDENTS HAVE LOST SCHOLARSHIPS AND JOBS AS A RESULT.

TALK ABOUT CONSEQUENCES. ONLINE CONTENT IS PUBLIC AND PERMANENT AND CAN HAVE A NEGATIVE IMPACT EVEN AFTER THEY LEAVE SCHOOL.

30% OF KIDS USE THE INTERNET WITH NO RESTRICTIONS. OVER HALF OF MIDDLE SCHOOLERS REPORT SEEING PORN ONLINE

TALK ABOUT APPROPRIATE ONLINE CONTENT AND DON'T BE AFRAID TO BLOCK WEBSITES, PAGES, OR CONTENT.

GAMING AND SOCIAL MEDIA ARE THE TOP WAYS PREDATORS GAIN ACCESS TO YOUR CHILD.

TALK ABOUT WHO THEY CAN CONNECT WITH ONLINE, WHAT INFORMATION THEY CAN SHARE, AND SET LIMITS AS TO WHERE AND WHEN THEY CAN BE ONLINE.
